Our Challenge: The Need for a Permanent Home



Current Limitations

- Reliance on rented or borrowed fields, leading to unpredictable availability.
- Lack of dedicated facilities:
 - Changing rooms
 - o Classrooms
 - Kitchen facilities
 - Proper training spaces

This unpredictability hinders our ability to consistently deliver and expand our vital programs.

The Opportunity: Our New Youth Empowerment Centre



After 15 years, we've secured 8 acres of land in the heart of Arusha for our own Youth Empowerment Centre. This will be more than just a facility; it will be a beacon of hope and development.

This Centre will provide

- A permanent home for FSA activities, ensuring stability and consistency.
- A vibrant hub for physical, mental, and social growth for thousands of young people.
- A safe and nurturing space, protecting children and young adults every year.
- State-of-the-art football pitches and dedicated educational classrooms.
- . Creating a Safe Space for girls and women to be active

Project Details & Funding Needs

We are embarking on a two-phase project to bring the Youth Empowerment Centre to life. Your support is crucial for our initial building efforts and unlocking future grants.

Phase 1- Start Building (2025)

We have secured seed funding from our partner Time2Help. We need to raise an additional **€20,000** by Christmas 2025 to complete Phase 1 priority items.

- Changing rooms (toilets, showers, tiles, painting) \$6,000
- Electricity setup & connection \$4,000
- Windows \$3,000
- Doors \$2,500
- Plaster, painting & finishing \$5,000

Total for Phase 1 Priority Items: \$20,500

Phase 2 (November 2025 - July 2026)

To unlock further grants and expand the center, we need an additional \$33,000.


